Supply List: Acrylic Painting Level 2 | FA242

Different tools produce different art. This course will teach you to use various papers as your delivery mechanism for color, shape and texture. You will create art by tearing, cutting, layering and gluing ephemera. You will also learn to turn "bleeding tissue paper" into "paint". The resulting art will be a unique expression of your interests and aesthetics.

Materials: Bleeding tissue paper and boards on which to create work will be provided.

Students must bring: -Tear sheets, papers including (but not limited to) cardboard, foils, tissue paper, photographs, any objects that can be glued, ephemera of interest (invitations, notes, cards et al) Bleeding tissue paper available from Amazon: <https://tinyurl.com/u9k6ftyr>

Though not required, you may also want 2" squares of bleeding tissue paper from Amazon: <https://tinyurl.com/4d23555d>

Glues including Elmer's clear liquid glue and/or Elmer's Washable School Glue Stick and/or Modge Podge.

Bristol paper or other heavy paper or boards, 8" x 10", 9" x 12" or larger on which you will practice techniques. For the second class you will also need at least 1 big board, such as 20" x 30" white Foam Core Board (available at Michael's or from Amazon.)

Scissors, water, a small palette or saucers into which you will pour the water, and a spray bottle with water in it (like you would use to spray plants or ironing) & paper towels.

Preparation: in addition to gathering the materials, students should wear protective clothing as the materials may stain fingers and clothing. And cover the surface on which you are working (a table or the floor, not an easel.)
